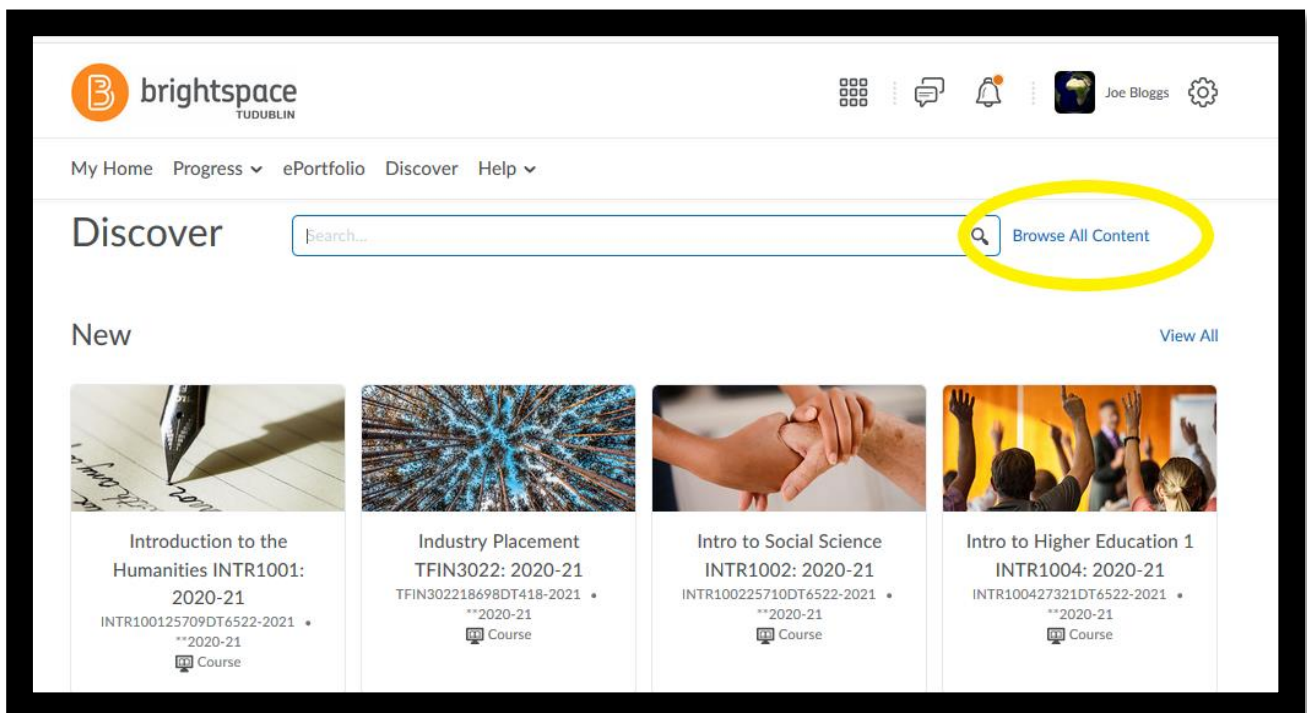


You can only un-enrol yourself from modules which you self-enrolled on using the Discover tool. If a lecturer added you to the module then you will need to contact him/her to request that they now remove you.

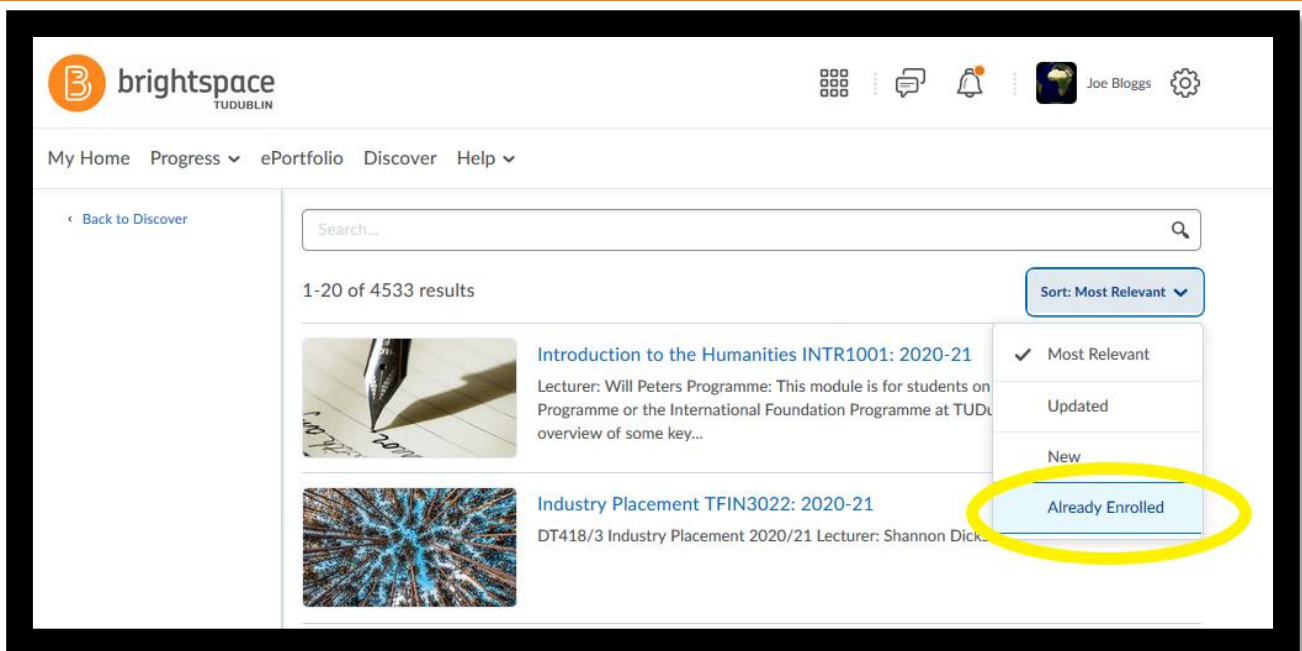
Self-enrolled on the wrong module? You can now UN-ENROL yourself from incorrect modules

- Log into Brightspace
- Take note of the module code you wish to remove yourself from
- Click into “Discover”
- Click **Browse All Content**, and then sort by **Already Enrolled**. All of your enrolled modules display in the search results.
- Select the module you want to unenroll from.
- From the (...) **Options** menu on the module details page, click **Unenroll**.
Note: The **Unenroll** option appears only if you self-enrolled on the module

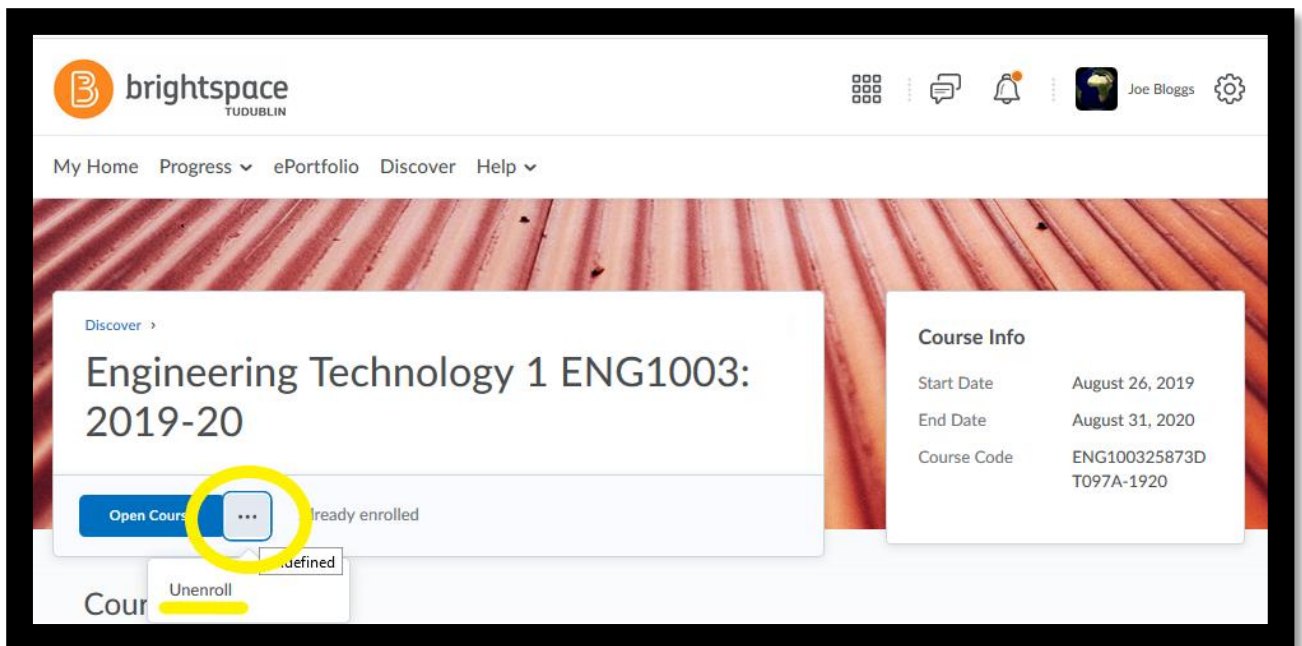
Screenshot 1: After clicking Discover click **Browse all Content**
