About Springboard+

Springboard+ is co-funded by the Government of Ireland and the European Social Fund as part of the ESF programme for employability, inclusion and learning 2014-2020. Springboard+ programmes are available to the unemployed, returners (formerly homemakers), formerly self-employed, the employed and recent graduates. All programmes lead to qualifications in enterprise sectors which are growing and need skilled personnel.

Who can apply?

The following are eligible to apply (subject to the applicant meeting all requirements, e.g. academic requirements):

- Returners. May apply to all programmes if they meet the nationality/visa requirement and residency criteria.
- People in employment. May apply to all programmes if they meet the nationality/visa requirement and residency criteria.
- The unemployed or formerly self-employed. All programmes are open to these category of applicants, with the exception of the two year part-time ICT conversion programmes which are not open to those in receipt of a Jobseekersrelated payment.



Apply Now

Eligibility

Each of the postgraduate certificates is open to those with Level 8 honours degree or equivalent. Applicants that do not meet this requirement may apply as a non-standard applicant (see application section on www.springboardcourses.ie). In addition, applicants will have to meet the eligibility requirements.

You will need to:

- 1. Be living fulltime in the Republic of Ireland
- 2. Have your own valid PPS Number
- 3.Meet the nationality/visa requirement
 - You are an EU/EEA/UK/Swiss national, or
 - You have permission to remain in Ireland as a family member of an EU citizen, or
 - You have Stamp 4 or Stamp 4 EU FAM on your GNIB residence card, or
 - You have official refugee status in Ireland / are here on the basis of refugee family reunification, or
 - You have been granted Humanitarian Leave to Remain in the State (prior to the Immigration Act 1999), or
 - You have permission to remain following the Minister's decision not to make a deportation order.
- 4. Have lived in either the EU, the EEA, the UK or Switzerland for at least 3 out of the last 5 years
 - If you are a Stamp 4 or Stamp 4 EU FAM holder, residency is calculated from the date you received your stamp. Any time before this cannot be counted.
 - If you have refugee status in Ireland, residency is counted from the date you applied for International Protection.

(NFQ Level 9)

The Postgraduate Certificate in Design Thinking and Innovation (LEVEL 9, 30 ECTS) and Innovation looks at how individuals and organisations use creativity and design thinking skills to identify and select opportunities that enable innovation. Creative problem-solving skills are developed and enhanced through a range of real-world activities. The programme will provide participants with a clear understanding of the importance of innovation. It will provide students with an excellent grasp of the principles underlying creative thinking and problem solving and how to map innovation opportunities, and will explore different types of innovation strategies. Participants will also discover tools and techniques for developing ideas and managing innovation.

On successful completion of the programme, participants will be able to:

- Demonstrate a systematic understanding of design thinking process using user involvement, problem framing and understanding, problem solving, experimentation, and visualisation in the context of startup and innovation projects.
- Examine innovation from the perspective of company strategy through the lens of products, services, business models, processes, experiences, and organisation.
- Select and apply agile management and collaboration tools.
- Be able to scope, plan, and execute a market research project for a new product, service, or market.
- Have a systematic understanding and be competent in developing the business model for a new venture.
