## Brightspace 11: Viewing and Understanding Brightspace Data

### Aim of this resource

This resource provides guidance on viewing and understanding Brightspace data. After working your way through this resource, you will have the knowledge necessary to monitor class progress, use the module overview widget, understand various module level reports and track student engagement.

#### Prerequisites for this resource:

- It is recommended that before working through this resource that you are familiar with Brightspace and have already worked through, or attended the workshops for, Brightspace 1 and 2.

<b>Class Progress Tool</b>	<p>How valuable would it be to have predictive practices in place so that you can access early warning about students who may be getting off track? The Class Progress tool provides lecturers with a high level view of student performance across the entire class and through four indicators of performance all at the lecturer’s fingertips making predictive practices and preventing student disengagement a priority. Students may want to use the Class Progress tool to keep track of their module-specific assignments and feedback. <b>Module Overview Widget</b>	<p>The Module Overview widget is a handy <b>dashboard</b> to see some analytic data about your module and your students. When you click into your module shell, the widget is usually to be found on the right-hand-side and above announcements. <b>Module Level Reports</b>	<p>The Module Overview Widget provides a number of module level reports that provides lecturers with a sense of who and how their modules are being accessed. <b>Class Engagement</b>	<p>Class Engagement is a Brightspace Insights-based tool for instructors that provides a consolidated view of activity, progress, and achievement in a module. The intuitive interface contains filtering, sorting, and searching capabilities, allowing instructors to easily identify top performers and students that might be at risk.
