Subject: Semester 1 Examinations - Update

Dear colleagues,

As you are all aware, we continue to work within the context of rapidly changing Covid numbers. As a result, the university has made some key decisions re the Semester 1 assessments to take place from next week. The specific points are:

- All written face to face (F2F) exams scheduled will be deferred;
- Remote exams already scheduled will take place as scheduled;
- Practical (particularly one to one) assessments will take place as scheduled – with appropriate risk assessments in place;
 - Please note that Schools will need to confirm and clarify details of this directly to the individual students involved;
- Schools are to review planned F2F assessments during the week commencing 3rd January in order to look to pivot to remote assessment within the current assessment period where possible;
- Remaining, required F2F assessments will be held in March 2022 (reading week);
 - Note that these F2F assessments will need alternative assessment modes defined and in place ready to implement if necessary due to the prevailing Covid environment.
