Dear Colleagues,

The success of the vaccination campaign has meant that we are all benefitting from the gradual easing of restrictions and many colleagues are now enjoying being on campus regularly. There are still several guidelines and restrictions to be aware of when you're on-campus:

- **Wear a [face covering](#).** This is mandatory in **all shared** indoor areas on campus, such as our libraries, offices, laboratories, studios, and workshops. If you cannot wear a face covering for reasons of a disability or a medical condition, please consult your GP for advice. A face-covering is not necessary outdoors, but please exercise caution in crowded areas.
- **Sanitise hands** on arrival and **wash hands frequently** while on campus; and please remember to cover any coughs and sneezes.
- **Check COVID-19 restrictions in the library** - such as bookable study spaces, 1m social distancing, and mandatory face coverings. For more information, please visit www.tudublin.ie/library.
- **Maintain physical distancing** where feasible, and avoid congregating in groups unless it is for an organised and controlled event.
- **Follow one-way circulation systems** that are in place in buildings across the University.
