Dear colleagues,

While the majority of teaching is being delivered virtually, TU Dublin students are continuing to attend campus for practical classes in laboratories, studios, workshops and kitchens. This means that there is regular activity in most buildings, with staff and students present when timetabled and approved.

Precautions are in place to ensure the safety of everyone concerned and anyone coming to campus needs to be constantly vigilant.

The key precautions continue to be:

- [Wear an effective face covering](#) – **not** a visor or face shield
- Sanitise hands on arrival and wash hands frequently while on campus
- Keep 2 metres distance from others and don't congregate in groups
- Remember to cover coughs and sneezes
- Where possible open windows and doors
