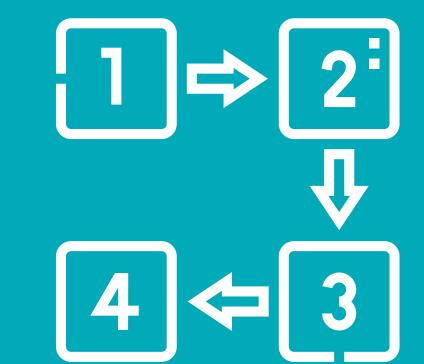


WHEN TO ACT



- If a student is in immediate danger of harming themselves or somebody else (e.g. suicide, plans to harm others, threatening violence).
- If a student is acting in a bizarre manner or out of contact with reality.
- If the student is in a situation where they could come to immediate serious harm.

FIRST STEPS



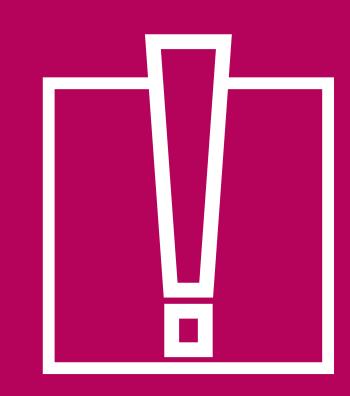
- Tell the student that you are concerned and that you will need to contact one of the following services:
 - TU Dublin Student
 Counselling Service
 or TU Dublin Student
 Health Centre, or
 the student's own
 GP (during normal
 business hours).
 - Involve the student in the deciding which service to contact and ring the appropriate service.
 Remain with the student.

WHAT IF?



- The student is unwilling to accept help, contact (ideally in the student's presence) TU Dublin Student Counselling Service, Student Health service or the student's own GP.
- unavailable or if the student refuses to use services contact 'next of kin' (try involving student in the decision unless this might further escalate the situation).

REME-MBER



- In the event of a life-threatening situation on-site:
 - if a student is or appears to be attempting suicide or has attempted suicide.
 - if a student is threatening to harm others.
- Contact the appropriate emergency services on 999 or 112: Ambulance, Gardai, etc.
