Ongoing	Sustainable Food Bank- Launched in November 2024, TU Dublin's sustainable food bank, ran by the SVP Society, takes food donated to FoodCloud and redistributes it to students on a weekly basis. Volunteers receive food safety training and maintain the storage and promotion of the bank. It works to raise awareness around food waste and sustainability
