

Bachelor of Music Vocal Studies

The BMus programme is designed for students who wish to develop their performance skills to a high level to suit a variety of contexts. Based at the Conservatoire, the BMus offers multiple pathways to allow students to focus on their strengths.

Performance platform classes with feedback from staff members and peer discussion

Language classes and stagecraft classes support performance studies

Advanced full-time and part-time students are eligible to audition for the award-winning Chamber Choir and Opera Ensemble

What will I study as a Vocal student?

One-to-one weekly tuition with a principal study teacher, tailored to the individual student's stage of development. This is supplemented by one-to-one repeteur classes with a pianist who specialises in vocal repertoire, to develop interpretative skills. Second study piano classes are also provided.

The Vocal department enjoys a close relationship with Irish National Opera, Blackwater Valley Opera Festival and Lyric Opera and Conservatoire students are regularly invited to participate in professional productions.
