The arrangements for end-of-year Musicianship assessments 2026 are as follows:

Intermediate Level 4, Senior Levels 1, 2 and 3

Written assessment:

Saturday 9th May beginning at 9.30 am

Junior Level 3, Intermediate Levels 1, 2 and 3
