

FIRE SAFETY-ALERTS FOR HEARING IMPAIRED STAFF AND STUDENTS

How to Set Up Your Phone for Fire Alarm Notification (For iPhone & Android users in University)

1. TURN ON ALARM ALERTS

iPhone	Android
<p>Enable Vibration: Go to: Settings > Accessibility > Touch > Vibration Make sure it's ON</p> <p>Turn On Sound Recognition (Alarms): Go to Settings > Accessibility > Sound Recognition > Turn on Sound Recognition > Tap Sounds > Alarms and switch all ON</p>	<p>Turn on Sound Notifications (Alarms)</p> <p>Go to: Settings > Accessibility > Hearing Enhancements > Sound Notifications</p> <p>▣ Open Sound Notifications > Make sure it's ON</p> <p>Activate Emergency Alarms in Sound Types</p>

2. ENABLE FLASH ALERTS FOR EMERGENCIES

iPhone	Android
<p>Enable LED Flash Alerts:</p> <p>Go to: Settings > Accessibility > Audio/Visual</p> <p>LED Flash for Alerts: Turn ON</p> <p>Flash on Silent (if needed)</p>	<p>Search 'Flash Notification' in your phone's settings: Activate</p>

Useful in dark rooms or when vibration may not be noticed.



IF YOU USE HEARING AIDS

Pair your hearing aid to your phone using Bluetooth.
Use compatible apps for custom alerts.
