

MINOR INJURY/ILLNESS

REQUIRES FIRST-AID TREATMENT:

- Contact local first responder noted in school/function safety arrangements
- Contact TU Dublin Security Control 01-2207615/01-2207616
- A first-aid kit and Automated External Defibrillator (AED) are available at front desks/reception areas

MODERATE INJURY/ILLNESS

REQUIRES MEDICAL ATTENTION:

- Arrange transport for the person to their local GP or A&E Department
- Students ONLY can attend the Student Health Centres (Mon Fri 9:00 17:00)

If in doubt of severity of injury/illness:

Contact Emergency Services on 112 or 999 (see below)

SERIOUS INJURY/ILLNESS

REQUIRES EMERGENCY CARE:

- Call emergency services on 112/999
- Keep the person comfortable until the ambulance arrives
- · A friend/responsible person should accompany the person to hospital
