How do I get to Aungier Street?

What are my parking options?

- TU Dublin encourages sustainable travel for all campus users and visitors.
- Car parking is available on streets adjacent to the University or in St Stephen's Green Shopping Centre.
- You can drop off stands and leaflets first at TU Dublin Aungier St. before parking.
- Please note all nearby car parks are privately owned and clampers operate at all times — keep an eye on your ticket time.

What time can I arrive at?

- Companies can set up from 11.00am.
- Members of the TU Dublin Career Development Centre Careers team and Student Ambassadors will be available throughout the event to assist you.
- They will be wearing TU Dublin sweatshirts.

What is included in the cost of attendance?

- Exhibition table and chairs
- Backdrop space
- Refreshments
- WiFi access

How many of us can attend?

- We kindly ask that a **MAX of three company representatives** attend the on-campus event.

What sort of stands/backdrops can I bring?

- Exhibition stands should **not exceed 6 feet in width** or consist of more than two standard pull-up stands.
- **Large exhibition stands/displays cannot be accommodated.**

Will I have access to electrical sockets?

- Access to power points **cannot be guaranteed.**

- Please ensure all your devices are fully charged before attending.

What other materials can I bring?

- Please bring tape to safely secure any cables.
- TU Dublin promotes sustainable practices, so consider carefully the types and quantities of brochures/hard copy materials you bring.

Is it ok if the name on my ticket or registration doesn't match the person who attends?

- Yes, we are happy to accommodate changes in personnel on employer stands.

What if I need to cancel my booking?

- You can cancel on Eventbrite at least 30 days before the event to receive a full refund.
- Cancellation less than 30 days before the event requires payment of the full attendance fee.
- No-shows on the day will not receive a refund and are obliged to pay the full cost.

Do I need to send you insurance documents?

- TU Dublin insurance covers attending employers/organisations for normal activities at the fair.
- You do **not** need to provide public indemnity insurance certificates or letters.
- Please check with your own insurers to ensure your policies cover this event.
