What are my parking options?

TU Dublin is committed to sustainable travel and encourages all campus users and visitors to consider this when planning their travel.

- Car parking is available on streets adjacent to the Bolton St. Campus or in Q-Park Parnell Street Car-Park.
- You can drop off stands and leaflets first at Bolton St (King's Inn Entrance) before parking your car.
- Please note all nearby car parks are privately owned and clampers operate at all Times so keep an eye on your ticket time.

What time can I arrive at?

- Members of the TU Dublin Career Development Centre Careers team and Student Ambassadors will be available throughout the event to assist you.

What sort of stands/backdrops can I bring?

- Exhibition stands should not exceed 6 feet in width or be larger than two standard pull-up stands.
- Large exhibition stands/displays cannot be accommodated.

Will I have access to electrical sockets?

- Access to power points cannot be guaranteed.
- Please ensure all your devices are fully charged before attending.

What other materials can I bring?

- Please bring tape to safely secure any cables.
- Regarding brochures and hard copy items, TU Dublin encourages sustainable practices. Please consider the types and quantities of materials you bring.

Is it okay if the name on my ticket or registration doesn't match the person who attends?

 Yes, changes in personnel on the employer stands are welcome and accommodated.

What if I need to cancel my booking?

- You can cancel on Eventbrite at least 30 days in advance to receive a full refund.
- If cancellation is less than 30 days before the event, full attendance fees apply.
- No refunds for no-shows on the day of the Fair.

Do I need to send you insurance documents?

- TU Dublin's insurance policy covers all attending employers/organisations and activities related to the careers/recruitment fair.
- You do not need to provide indemnity insurance certificates.
- However, please check with your own insurers to ensure your professional indemnity and public liability policies cover this event.
