


Organising your argument

An argument essay structure is generally organised in two different ways.

- 1. **Block structure** is where the paragraphs in the main body are divided separately into for or against. This is where you present all of the evidence for one side of the argument at the first half of the essay and then present all of the evidence for the counterargument in the second half of the essay (**See left hand side below**).
- 2. **Point-by-Point structure** where each main body paragraph has an argument followed by the counter argument (See right hand side below)
