## What is the International Bridging Programme?

The International Bridging Programme at TU Dublin is an intensive 8-week programme developed especially for international students who need further English language preparation to progress to their postgraduate studies at TU Dublin. If you have already met the academic requirements for direct entry and just need to further improve your English, it is the ideal pathway for you.



## English Language Requirements



Applicants whose first language is not English may be required to provide evidence of English language proficiency.

The university accepts multiple English language proficiency tests, details of which are available on our website at [tudublin.ie/elr](https://tudublin.ie/elr). The certificate of your English language standard must have been issued within 2 years of the expected start of your course.

In relation to IELTS, the minimum score is 6.0 with no less than 6 in each component unless otherwise stated. Please be aware that some programmes require a higher score. Details can be found on individual programme pages.
