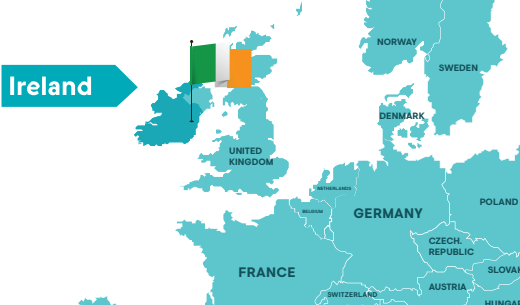

Accommodation

TU Dublin books space with a number of campus-style accommodation providers who give a discount to our students. They try to place students of similar courses and campuses together. Host family accommodation is also very popular with our international students.

You only pay for the weeks you are there and it will give you a chance to find your feet in a new city. For more information check out our Student Pad accommodation website at tudublinstudentpad.ie/accommodation which is a database of accommodation available for our students.

- **Host Family** - around €165 to €220 per week with utilities included and some providing meals.
- **Student Accommodation** - prices range from €900 to €1100 for a single room with an en suite bathroom per month.
- **Private Rented Accommodation** - prices range from €600 to €800 per month.

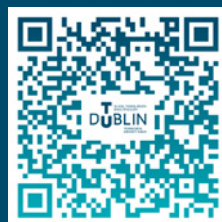
