Note - Glossary of Terms:

Annex 5: From an architecture programme recognised under Annex V of EU Directive 2005/36/E;

Transitional programme arrangements / prerequisites: Extra learning which the candidate may be required to complete before entry to the MArch programme;

Evidence of Inquiry: Evidence of the candidate's knowledge acquired in a subject area of the intended research project through work, study or other experience.

Portfolio: Examples of work carried out in the candidate's previous studies which represent the candidate's skills and interests.
