With the Charity Governance Code becoming a requirement for all charities there is a need to equip and enable charity trustees to perform their roles effectively and with probity. With over 11,000 registered charities in Ireland this programme will assist organisations and their trustees to effectively fulfil their roles within an organisation in line with regulatory framework and to be professionally competent within the team to do so.

Entry Requirements:

Applicants may meet one of the following entry requirements:

- Graduates of FETAC level 5 or 6 awards are eligible.
- Leaving Certificate – applicants must have a pass in five subjects (ordinary level) in the Leaving Certificate to include Mathematics and English or Irish, or an equivalent qualification.
- Mature applicants (i.e. those who are aged 23 years or more on January 1st in the year of entry) are also eligible to apply. All aspects of the applicants prior learning and work experience will be assessed.
